

New Workshop Equipment by Hella Gutmann

- **Extended product range for motorcycle workshops**
- **Diagnostic tool mega macs 56 Bike optional with integrated multimeter**

Ihringen, Germany, October 2016. At Intermot in Cologne from 5.-9. October 2016 Hella Gutmann first presents it's mega macs 56 Bike. The market launch for this premium diagnostic tool is announced for 2017. It will extend the Hella Gutmann portfolio of professional multi-brand diagnostic tools for motorcycles, scooters, quads and trikes.

For the diagnosis and other tasks that require communication with the motorcycle's ECUs, workshops can choose their desired solution from the Hella Gutmann product range for the motorcycle branch. Their choice is among the mega macs PC Bike software solution for laptop or tablet, the handheld tool mega macs 42 SE Bike and the new mega macs 56 Bike. Furthermore Hella Gutmann offers economical special solutions for motorcycle workshops who also work on cars.

The new top range diagnostic tool mega macs 56 Bike operates with a fast capacitive touchscreen which makes it easy to use like a smart phone. However, the tool is shock and splash proof. A version with an integrated fast 2-channel multimeter is optional.

All mega macs bike solutions are operating with the same software. Thanks to a simple menu navigation one is quickly taken to functions as trouble codes, service instructions, basic settings, codings, etc. According to all actual diagnostic tools by Hella Gutmann a Bluetooth VCI (vehicle communication interface) ensures the wireless communication with the vehicle.

The small communication module is docked onto the diagnostic interface of the vehicle via a manufacturer-specific adapter. With a total of 26 adapters, vehicles of the following brands can be diagnosed: Aprilia, BMW, BRP, Derbi, Gilera, Moto Guzzi, MV Agusta, Piaggio, Vespa, Malaguti, Adiva, Bimota, Cagiva, Gas Gas, KVN-Motors, Ducati, Harley Davidson, Honda, Husqvarna, Kawasaki, KTM, Husaberg, Kymco, Peugeot and Suzuki. For some manufacturers, multiple adapters are available. For example, BMW, MV Agusta and Harley Davidson have two adapters each covering all models of these brands. Three twin adapters take care of all Kawasaki models.

A wealth of new possibilities

With the latest software update in July 2016, more than 30 models from BMW, Ducati, Kawasaki and KTM were added to the range, including the KTM Adventure 1290 which was launched last year featuring systems such as ABS, damper control, adaptive headlights, tire pressure monitoring, immobilizer, etc. It goes without saying that the standard functions such as reading/deleting trouble codes, parameter requests, actuator control, basic settings and service resets are also available. The numerous new BMW models include the C650 Sport scooter which was launched in 2016 and

which is fitted with a standardized 16-pin OBD plug ex works. This means that there is no need for any additional adapters. The presentation mode of the mega macs is particularly helpful for troubleshooting on all R-1200 and F-800 models. This mode makes it possible for the user to activate systems such as heated handlebars, seat heating, damper adjustment, etc. without starting the engine.
